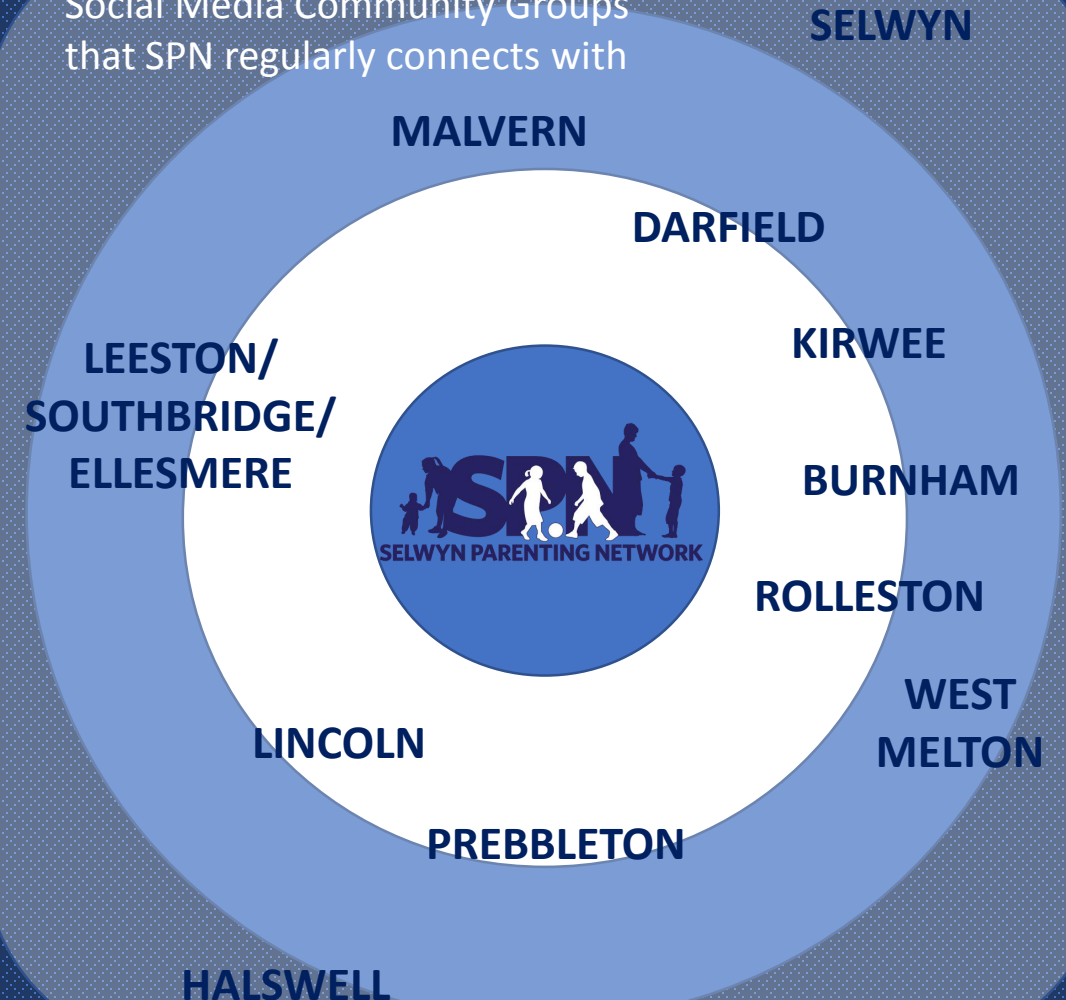
Our presence on social media has continued to grow over the past year, and has become our most widely used marketing tool to connect with parents and caregivers across Selwyn.
